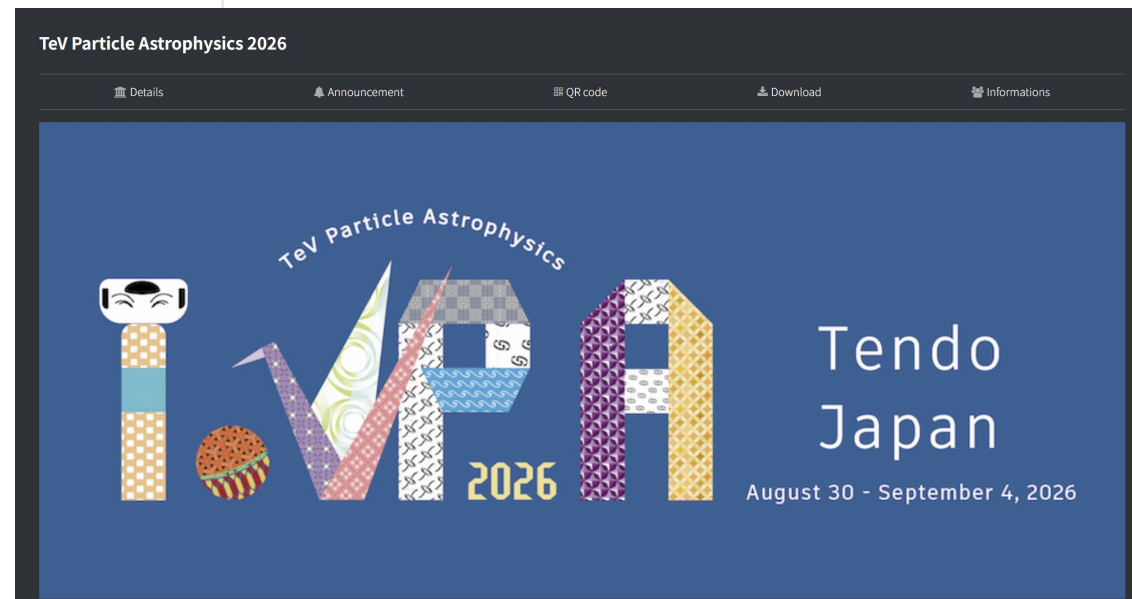




PHOTO SESSION

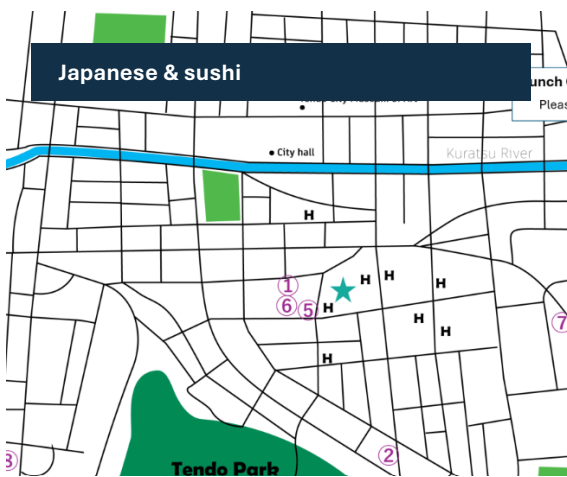

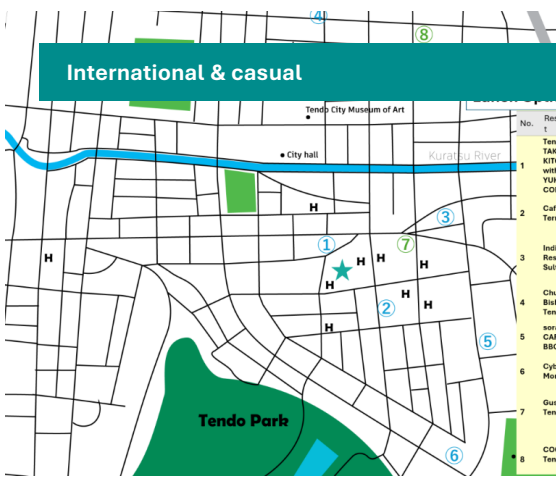

Local essentials

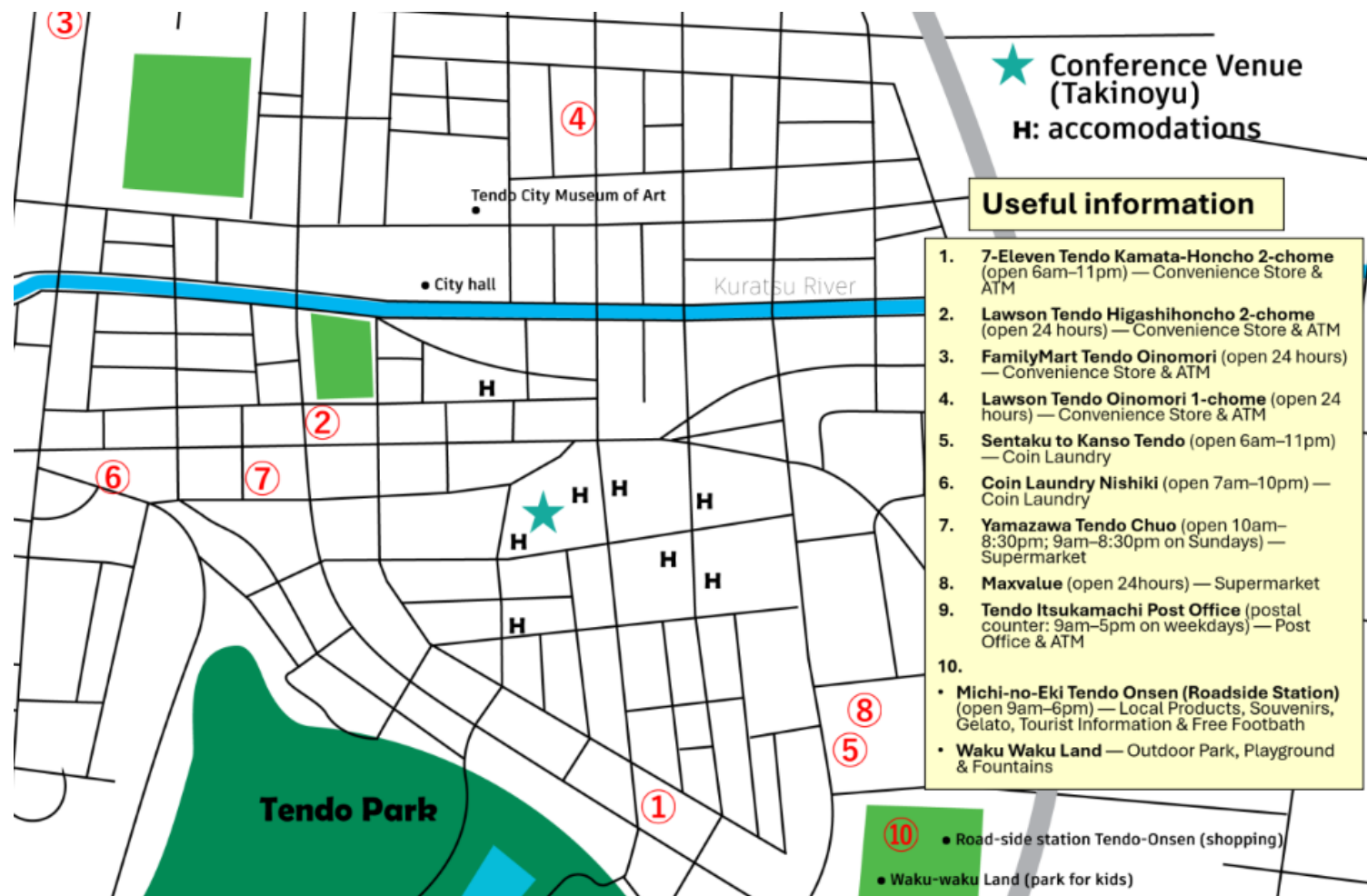
Cash, convenience stores, laundry, supermarkets, post office, and local-product shops.
